



MINUTES OF THE

MAY 12, 2008

Call to Order

The SLHS Band Boosters meeting was called to order by Jeff Jernberg, President, at 7:13 PM, in the Band Hall at SLHS.

Members Present

A quorum was met.

Review of Minutes

The Band Boosters minutes of April 21, 2008 were reviewed. Albert Lozano made a motion to approve the minutes. Linda Pearsall seconded. The motion carried.

Treasurer's Report

Jeff Jernberg reported that some bills are coming in, and we have about \$10,000 that will be paid.

Jeff reported that we have about \$69,000 in our checking account.

For the 2008-2009 school year the Band Boosters has \$10,000 carryover.

Mr. Archer stated that the money for UIL will be coming soon.

Jeff also explained the Annual Operating Plan for the SLHS Band Boosters for 2008-2009. The proposed total income from Band and Guard is \$275,299.00. The proposed total expenses from Band and Guard is \$275,280.00.

Linda Pearsall made a motion to approve this Annual Operating Plan for 2008-2009. Leslie Flattery seconded. The motion carried.

The tax-free days will be Money Day and the Mum Shoppe. George Duggan made a motion to approve these tax-free days. Albert Lozano seconded. The motion carried.

### Membership

George Duggan reported that at the Ice Cream Social and Membership Drive, we received \$3,800.00. This money will be deposited at the beginning of the next fiscal year.

### Uniforms

Diane Armijo stated that currently band students need to bring some bow-ties that have been left at home. She reported that there is also one tuxedo missing and five formal dresses that need to be returned.

Diane stated that on August 9, socks, gloves, and performance wear will be available.

Help will also be needed on August 4 to help with fitting.

### Chaperones

Leslie Flattery stated that Senior parents are welcome to chaperone the State Solo and Ensemble Contest on May 26.

### Guard

Feona Attaway stated that they had Guard tryouts. The girls also attended some camps.

For next school year, Guard will have guard girls and guard guys.

Mr. Archer stated that the junior high schools will be contacted about Guard.

## Fundraising

Priscilla Webking explained that \$33,000 comes from fundraising. \$17,000 comes from the Mum Shoppe. So, we need workers at the Mum Shoppe.

Priscilla emphasized that a volunteer band booster is badly needed to oversee and lead the Mum Shoppe, otherwise some other organization might take over this fundraiser. Gloria Hurliman, who has a graduating senior this year, is very willing to help this lead person.

Priscilla continued to state that the SLHS Band Boosters first fundraiser for 2008-2009 is the entertainment book sale. Each student should try to sell 10 books at \$20.00 a book.

## Communications

Albert Lozano stated we made \$200.00 from Good Search and \$25.00 in one month in Good Shopping.

For senior parents, an alumni list is going to be created.

Also, the Board e-mail addresses are going to change.

## Business

Jeff Jernberg made a motion that the SLHS Band Boosters allocate up to \$44,000 for instruments and music for the school year. Tari Davis seconded. The motion carried.

Jeff Jernberg thanked the SLHS Band Boosters for all their help throughout the school year. He also thanked the Board, and all the previous Board members for their help!

## Director's Corner

Mr. Archer announced that he was still addressing what will be needed for 2008-2009.

Damon stated that until the SLHS Budget is done, the school cannot promise anything to the Band.

Some of the needs are first to upgrade the sound system, percussion equipment, alto flute, and other needs.

We might have to share tubas.

Secondly, Mr. Archer stated that we need to stock up our own music library.

Mr. Archer added that they had DI tryouts. Drum majors will go to camp in Monroe, LA.

On May 20, the Concert and Symphonic Bands will have their Spring Concert.

On May 24, the Wind Symphony Band will have its Spring Concert.

On May 26, the State Solo and Ensemble Contest will be held in Austin.

June 2-5 is the Drumline Camp 1.

Mr. Archer stated that our first SLHS graduating class is coming up on June 1, 2008.

Mr. Archer greatly thanked all Senior Band Board members!!

Damon stated that 65 eighth graders are coming into the SLHS band. Ten students have not decided yet if they are going to continue or not.

Tari Davis made a motion to adjourn the SLHS Band Boosters meeting. Leslie Flattery seconded. The motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:55 PM.
